ORANGE

Orange wines are white wines made like red wines, with a prolonged maceration of crushed skins and seeds. These wines are incredibly versatile - they are delicate enough to work with fish and vegetables and strong enough due to the tannins to also compliment heavier dishes. The perfect wines for sharing plates.

Ca'Liptra 'Caliptra' Bianco, Marche, Italy, 2017 – 8.8/35.2/51
A classic expression of Verdicchio bitterness. Subtle yet expressive, textured and layered.

Vino Bianco, Cantina Giardino, Campania, Italy, 2017, 1.5 litres – 9.6/39/110
White only by name, this is a refreshing wild and cloudy skin-contact wine with a lot of energy.

Orange, Stapleton & Springer, Moravia, Czech Republic, 2017 – 10.5/41/61.5
Technically, not an orange wine, this is an expressive Pinot Noir. Unfiltered, unfiltered & bright - a light amber colour with black cherry fruit nose and a peppery intensity.

Skerk Ograde, Carso, Friuli, Italy, 2016 – 14/57/85
Hues of pink and rust. Sandi's skin contact wine beautifully showcases the land's iron-rich red soil & its traditional grapes Vitovska & Mavalsia.

Glück, Weingut Werlitschm, Styria, Austria, 2014 – 87
A blend of biodynamic Chardonnay & Sauvignon Blanc grapes from the mountainous part of Austria. This wine is Austere, fresh but with an intriguing complexity.

Kydonitsa Barrique, Ktima Ligas, Pella, Greece, 2015 – 93
Hand-harvested Kydnoista grapes. Smooth and aromatic with great depth & focus.

Montepulciano/Sangiovese blend. Medium bodied, fruit packed and structured red, delicious natural style.

La Folle Berthe, David Foubert, Loire, France, 2017 **9/36/54**

Supple on the palate with chalky tannins, followed by discreet notes of red currant and white pepper.

L'Excentrique, Gregory Guillaume, Alba-la-Romaine,
Ardèche, France 2017 **9.5/39/57**

Smooth and well-balanced wine from artisan winemaker Gregory Guillaume. Very drinkable, if slightly atypical, Merlot.

Alea Viva, Andrea Occhipinti, Lazio, Italy, 2016 **10/40/60**

Dry red from vines planted on Elba Island in Lazio's Lake Bolzena. Aromatic and spicy nose with an alluring earthiness on the palate.

La Compagnon, Domaine Ledogar, Corbières,
Languedoc, France, 2016 **62**

Medium bodied palate with a rich mouthfeel and chalky tannin.

Flavours of plum and black cherry with acidity lifting the fruit into cranberry.

Che Chauvio, Les Enfant Sauvages,
Cotes Catalanes, France, 2016 **11/43/64**

Cinsault grapes infused with Syrah juice. Calm, fresh and satisfyingly well-rounded without being rich.

Dva Duby, Frankovka, Moravia, Czech Republic, 2015 **13/47/72**

Bright, black and red cherry, blueberry bouquet with earthy notes. balsamic finish. Very fresh and enjoyable.

Los Pasitos, Suertes del Marqués, Tenerife, Spain, 2014 **80**

A versatile and elegant wine, feels crisp and fresh with cherry and plum aromas finish. Very fresh and enjoyable.

Brutal, Christian Tschida, Burgenland, Austria 2017 (1.5L) **17/70/190**

A well balanced and expressive Pinot Noir from 40 y.o. vines in the shores of Neusiedlersee lake. One barrel of this wine exists- drink it while it lasts!
