ORANGE

Orange wines are white wines made like red wines, with a prolonged maceration of crushed skins and seeds. These wines are incredibly versatile - they are delicate enough to work with fish and vegetables and strong enough due to the tannins to also compliment heavier dishes. The perfect wines for sharing plates.

Ca'Liptra 'Caliptra' Bianco, Marche, Italy, 2017 – **8.5/34/48**
A classic expression of Verdicchio bitterness. Subtle yet expressive, textured and layered.

Orange, Stapleton & Springer, Moravia, Czech Republic, 2017 – **10.5/41/61.5**
Technically, not an orange wine, this is an expressive Pinot Noir. Unfined, unfiltered & bright- a light amber colour with black cherry fruit nose and a peppery intensity.

Domaine Matassa, "Cuvée Alexandria", Côtes Catalanes, Languedoc-Roussillon, France, 2017 – **10.5/42/64**
Complex and nutty aromas with notes of ripe orchard fruits and a touch of sweet herbs.

Skerk Ograde, Carso, Friuli, Italy, 2016 – **14/57/85**
Hues of pink and rust. Sandi's skin contact wine beautifully showcases the land's iron-rich red soil & its traditional grapes Vitovska & Mavalsia.

Kydonitsa Barrique, Ktima Ligas, Pella, Greece, 2015 – **90**
Hand-harvested Kydnoista grapes. Smooth and aromatic with great depth & focus.
