*Complex, fresh and mineral. A great wine from a true artisan.*

Marcio Lopes, Pequenos Rabentos Loureiro, DOC Vinho Verde, Portugal, 2017 **39**  
*Wine for any occasion. Crisp and aromatic, with clean and herbaceous finish.*

Aurora, Falerio dei Colli Ascolani, Marche, Italy, 2016 **7.5/30/41**  
*Fresh golden apples, delicious pears, and a touch of hay.*

Force Majeure, Johan Meyer, Swartland, South Africa, 2017 **42**  
*Dry grown bush vines. Savoury and Peachy with a honeyed "chenin" finish.*

Les Greilles, Domaine Causse Marines, Gaillac, France, 2015 **9/36/53**  
*Mauzac & Loin-de-l'Oeil grapes with a little Muscadelle, Chenin Blanc & Semillon thrown in. This is a complex wine that strikes a balance between rich & acidic- perfect with sharing dishes.*

Malvazija, Marko Fon, Slovenia, 2015 **56**  
*Pure and vibrant with a savoury and herbal note.*

Les Molates, Domaine des Marines Blanches, Cotes du Jura, France, 2015 **10/40/60**  
*Jura Chardonnay notes of toasted walnuts, wildflower honey, mango flesh and sea breeze.*

Himmel Auf Erden, Christian Tschida, Burgenland, Austria, 2015 **70**  
*Light peach on the nose with incredible minerality and a long finish.*

## ORANGE

Orange wines are white wines made like red wines, with a prolonged maceration of crushed skins and seeds. These wines are incredibly versatile and can be enjoyed with almost anything - they are delicate enough to work with fish and vegetables and strong enough due to the tannins to also compliment meat and heavier dishes. The perfect wines for sharing plates.

Ca'Liptra 'Caliptra' Bianco, Marche, Italy, 2015 – **8.5/34/48**  
*A classic expression of Verdicchio bitterness. Subtle yet expressive, textured and layered.*

Dinavolino, Azienda Agricola Denavolo, Emilia Romagna, Italy, 2015 – **9.6/39/55.5**  
*The tannins bring elegance to the playful nature of the grapes. Ripe aromas with a honeyed finish.*

Himmel Auf Erden II Maische Vergoren, Christian Tschida, Burgenland, Austria, 2016 – **73**  
*Wild and unfiltered wine full of citrus and herbs. Delicate yet powerful.*

Skerk Ograde, Carso, Friuli, Italy, 2015 – **14/57/85**  
*Hues of pink and rust. Sandi's skin contact wine beautifully showcases the land's iron-rich red soil & its traditional grapes Vitovska & Mavalsia.*
