Gran Cerdo Blanco, Gonzalo Grijalba, Rioja, Spain, 2018 **5.85/18/27**
Pale colour, very fresh with good acidity, like a crisp green apple

Le Pianure, Grave, Friuli, Italy, 2018 **30**
An elegant wine, with floral and fruit notes on the nose and hints of honey and ripened fruits.

Chateau Morgues du Gres, Francois Collard, **7/26/36**
Costieres-de-Nimes, Rhone, France, 2018
This wine has the intriguing combination of fresh fruit scents and juiciness, characteristic of a classic white Rhône.

Cora, Loxarel, Penedes, Spain, 2018 **7.8/29.5/43.5**
Fun and exciting Catalan white, that's never over the top. The wine's palate lighten up nicely with citrus and quince and it finishes dry, clean and lively.

Trebbiano D'abruzzo, Valle Reale, Abruzzo, Italy, 2017 **46**
Established in 1998, the Pizzolo family began their wine journey when they resurrected an old vineyard on the family property. They farm biodynamically and harvest Trebbiano and Montepulciano grapes native to the Abruzzo mountains.

Malvazija, Marko Fon, Slovenia, 2015 **56**
Pure and vibrant with a savoury and herbal note.

Zacmau, Domaine Causse Marines, Gaillac, France, 2016 **57**
An authentic expression of Mauzac. The grapes are hand-harvested while fining and filtration are kept to a minimum. The wine, however, remains classic, complex and honest to its terroir.

Pinot Blanc, Marc Tempe, Zellenberg, Alsace, France, 2016 **11/44/65**
The nose is extremely enticing with hints of honey, marzipan and ripe melon.

Jurançon Sec, Domaine de Souch, Jurançon, France, 2013 **10.5/42/72**
Complex aromas together in a full feeling yet bright, medium style wine.

Pa'ro Bianco, Buccia Nera, Tuscany, Italy, 2016 **12/51/76**
Balanced by good acidity and minerality, the light presence of tannin leaves

*Soft, floral wine with a self-assured minerality
and a thin streak of tannins.*

Agno, La Stoppa, Emilia Romagna, Italy, 2013 **15/60/87**
*One of Italy's benchmark wines.
Rich and nutty with a wonderful texture. We love it!*
