Cora, Loxarel, Penedes, Spain, 2018 **38**

Xarel-lo, & Muscat of Alexandrai blend. A fresh, modern take on traditional Catalan grapes. Acidic, but not sharp, full bodied but never overbearing

Feherburgundi, Franz Weninger, Sopron, Hungary, 2016 **8/45**

An under-estimated grape variety, this Pinot Blanc stands up against its Bourgogne cousins. The gentle oak ageing alongside extended lees contact allows the wine to bring out a creamy but firm texture.

Hamdani Jandali, Cremisan, Bethlehem, Palestine, 2018 **8.5/49**

A blend of two indigenous grape varieties with pineapple on the nose and a long finish. Made by Salesian monks in the hills of Shaffa, Bethlehem.

Mise du Printemps, Josmeyer, Alsace, France, 2018 **63**

Spring blossom, white peach aromas open up to a moreish palate with a fleshy texture. Ripe apple and honey lift the finish

Rosso Piceno Superiore, Aurora, Marche, Italy, 2017

— 45

Montepulciano/Sangiovese blend. Medium bodied, fruit packed and structured red, delicious natural style.

Baladi, Cremisan, Bethlehem, Palestine, 2018 — 8.5/49

Made from 100% Baladi grapes grown in the sunny hills of Shaffa. Warm and round with notes of cherries and blueberries.

Frappato, Pianogrillo, Sicily, Italy, 2018 — 9/52

Bright ruby-red colour with an intense nose. This Frappato has a perfect balance of body and fruit, with disarming simplicity.

Mâcon Rouge, Vignes du Maynes, Burgundy, France, 2017 — 81

Originally set up by the Benedictine order in 910, the vineyard has never had chemicals, pesticides and herbicides use on it. Officially organic since 1952 and biodynamic since 1998.

An Autumnal favourite at NOPI. A classic, unfiltered Gamay with a spicy palate and invigorating fresh fruits on the palate

Les Brunelles, Domaine Ledogar, 72

GP Aude, Languedoc, France, 2015

It's pure cinsault of old vines, silky and endowed with a very beautiful fruit.

INTRIGUING OUTSIDERS

Off the beaten track, packed with memorable flavours & textures

Ruby, Krasna Hora, Moravia, Czech Republic, 2018 8.5/41

A field blend of mostly Zweigelt, Saint Laurent and Pinot Noir. Despite the light texture and colour, the wine has strong flavours of macerated berries and fresh-ground peppercorns.

Lamie Delle Vigne, Cristiano Guttarolo, Puglia, Italy, 2017 53

Primitivo packed with pure, sun-kissed fruit, scrubby herbs and a mineral streak.

Les Traverses, Domaine Courbissac, Minervois, France, 2017 9.5/57

Hand-harvested Grenache, Syrah & Mourvedre grapes. A smooth and juicy wine with a Mediterranean bouquet of ripe red fruits, thyme and lavender.

Adonis, La Grapperie, Cateaux du Loire, France, 2017 62

Pineau d'Aunis fermented as whole bunches. Juicy, light and bright but with a lot of complexity.
