ONE GRAPE WONDERS

Verdicchio, Societa Agricola Accadia, Marche, Italy, 2019 38

Light, crisp, nutty and mineral with a slight sourness, from a great producer called Angelo Accadia.

Nolem, Complémen' Terre, Loire, France, 2019 8/47.5

Traditional iteration of Muscadet. Manually harvested Melon de Bourgogne grapes from 40 year-old vines.

Lovamor, Alfredo Maestro, Castilla y Leon, Spain, 2020 8.5/51

Playful & fun biodynamic Albillo from Northern Spain. Skin contact of 8 days gives this wine spine and spirit. Dry & slightly acidic with lots of pears & bergamot on the palate.

Les Grandes Hermines, Loire, France, 2019 56

A vibrant, refreshing Chenin Blanc with a lick of salt on the finish.

Hibernal, Petr Kocarik, Moravia, Czech Republic, 2019 13/78

A cross between Siebel and Riesling, Hibernal is reminiscent of a late-harvest Sauvignon Blanc, an expansive rich palate with apricots & heather on the nose.

INTRIGUING OUTSIDERS

La Blanca, Krasna Hora, Moravia, Czech Republic, 2019 7.5/44

A field blend of Gewürztraminer, Pinot Gris, Riesling, Sauvignon Blanc. This is a dry, unfiltered wine with slight but rich tannins that come from the partial skin contact during fermentation.

Aurora, Falerio dei Colli Ascolani, Marche, Italy, 2018 45

A blend of Trebbiano, Pecorino & Passerina. Fresh golden apples, delicious pears, and a touch of hay.

Pa'ro Bianco, Buccia Nera, Tuscany, Italy, 2016 12/76

A meditation on acidity and minerality, the light presence of tannin leaves an intriguing golden colour and a pleasant, dry mouthfeel.

Soft, juicy and full of energy. A real gem from one of the world's greatest natural wine making co-ops.

Morgon Classique, Jean Foillard, **67**

Beaujolais, France, 2019

An autumnal favourite at NOPI. A classic, unfiltered Gamay with a spicy finish and invigorating fresh fruits on the palate.

Les Brunelles, Domaine Ledogar, **72**

Languedoc, France, 2015

Pure, romantic Cinsault from old vines, silky and endowed with a very beautiful fruit on the nose.

PLAYFUL & FRESH

Toupette A Lundi, Domaine de Bablut, **7/43**

Anjoi, France, 2020

A fun, easy going Grolleau - a real thirst-quencher. From the Bablut family who have been making wines since the 1500's. In 1996, they re-converted to organic and work biodynamically. Served chilled.

Trait Gamay, Remi Sedes, Loire, France, 2018 **11/55**

Complex, structured Gamay. Intense, bright cherry fruit backed up with a lovely, smooth mouthfeel.

Karmazin, Petr Korab, Moravia, **60**

Czech Republic, 2019

A gorgeous Blaufränkisch with rounded, soft tannins, smooth texture and a calm acidity.

Sisto NA 13, Carussin, Piedmont, Italy, 2013 **18/84**

A small release from the traditionally-minded winemakers. Rich & fresh all at once, this is a very fruit-driven and charming Nebbiolo.

Primitivo di Salento, Mocavero, Puglia, Italy 2019 – **6.5/36**

The taste is full, beautiful and powerful, the finish is juicy and very sturdy.

Rosso Piceno Superiore, Aurora, Marche, Italy, 2019 – **45**

Montepulciano/Sangiovese blend. Medium bodied, fruit packed red. Delicious natural style from a lesser-explored region of Italy.

Frappato, Pianogrillo, Sicily, Italy, 2019 – **52**

Bright ruby-red with an intense nose. This Frappato has a perfect balance of body & fruit, with disarming simplicity.

Princé, La Grange aux Belles, Angers, France, 2018 – **12/68**

Organic Cabernet Franc grapes grown on the slopes of the Aubance river in Anjou. Supple, elegant structure. A light body with good length.

Mâcon Rouge, Vignes du Maynes, Burgundy, France, 2017 – **81**

Originally set up by the Benedictine order in 910, the vineyard has never had chemicals, pesticides and herbicides used on it. Officially organic since 1952 and biodynamic since 1998.
