ONE GRAPE WONDERS

Verdicchio, Societa Agricola Accadia,
Marche, Italy, 2019 **38**

Light, crisp, nutty and mineral with a slight sourness, from a great producer called Angelo Accadia.

La Croix Moriceau, Complémen' Terre,
Loire, France, 2020 **8/47.5**

Traditional iteration of Muscadet. Manually harvested Melon de Bourgogne grapes from 40 year-old vines.

Lovamor, Alfredo Maestro, Castilla y Leon, Spain, 2020 **8.5/51**

Playful & fun biodynamic Albillo from Northern Spain. Skin contact of 8 days gives this wine spine and spirit. Dry & slightly acidic with lots of pears & bergamot on the palate.

Les Grandes Hermines, Loire, France, 2019 **56**

A vibrant, refreshing Chenin Blanc with a lick of salt on the finish.

Elbling, Jonas Dostert, Mosel, Germany, 2020 **11/65**

Made with Elbling, an ancient grape variety, this is a crisp & refreshing wine with hints of peach and pear.

Hibernal, Petr Kocarik, Moravia, Czech Republic, 2019 **78**

A cross between Siebel and Riesling, Hibernal is reminiscent of a late-harvest Sauvignon Blanc, an expansive rich palate with apricots & heather on the nose.

INTRIGUING OUTSIDERS

Aurora, Falerio dei Colli Ascolani, Marche, Italy, 2018 **7.6/45**

A blend of Trebbiano, Pecorino & Passerina. Fresh golden apples, delicious pears, and a touch of hay.

Belle Naturelle, Stefanie & Elwin Jurtschitsch, Kamptal,
Austria, 2019 **62**

This clean, dry Gruner Veltiner is made of terraced vineyards in Langenlois. It's macerated for ten days on skins. Naturally cloudy, elderflower and chamomile on the nose and black tea and peach on the palate.

Pa'ro Bianco, Buccia Nera, Tuscany, Italy, 2016 **12/76**

A meditation on acidity and minerality, the light presence of tannin leaves an intriguing golden colour and a pleasant, dry mouthfeel.

Montepulciano/Sangiovese blend. Medium bodied, fruit packed red. Delicious natural style from a lesser-explored region of Italy

Les Brunelles, Domaine Ledogar, **72**

Languedoc, France, 2015

Pure, romantic Cinsault from old vines, silky and endowed with a very beautiful fruit on the nose.

PLAYFUL & FRESH

Topette A Lundi, Domaine de Bablut, **7/43**

Anjoi, France, 2020

A fun, easy going Grolleau - a real thirst-quencher. From the Bablut family who have been making wines since the 1500's. In 1996, they re-converted to organic and work biodynamically. Served chilled.

Trait Gamay, Remi Sedes, Loire, France, 2018 **11/55**

Complex, structured Gamay. Intense, bright cherry fruit backed up with a lovely, smooth mouthfeel.

Karmazin, Petr Korab, Moravia, **60**

Czech Republic, 2019

A gorgeous Blaufränkisch with rounded, soft tannins, smooth texture and a calm acidity.

Sisto NA 13, Carussin, Piedmont, Italy, 2013 **18/84**

A small release from the traditionally-minded winemakers. Rich & fresh all at once, this is a very fruit-driven and charming Nebbiolo.

Rackham, Laurent Cazotte, Villeneuve-sur-Vère, France, 2020 – **8.5/50**

Dark purple colour, aromas of berries and cherries which follow on the palate. Soft tannins with balanced acidity.

Frappato, Pianogrillo, Sicily, Italy, 2019 – **52**

Bright ruby-red with an intense nose. This Frappato has a perfect balance of body & fruit, with disarming simplicity.

Princé, La Grange aux Belles, Angers, France, 2018 – **12/68**

Organic Cabernet Franc grapes grown on the slopes of the Aubance river in Anjou. Supple, elegant structure. A light body with good length.

Brouilly, Jea-Claude Lapalu, Beaujolais, France, 2020 – **81**

Intense and bitter-sweet in the mouth with a soothing warmth, the finish is lingering and slightly spicy.

Fledermaus Rot, 2 NaturKinder, Franken, Germany, 2019 – **13/76**

High-energy red. White pepper tingles alongside black cherry, spice, raspberry, eucalyptus and zingy acidity.
