This wine is surprisingly refreshing and robust.*

Trebbiano D'abruzzo, Valle Reale, Abruzzo, Italy, 2017 **46**
*The Pizzolo family re-established an old vineyard
on the ancestral property in 1998. They farm biodynamically
and only harvest grapes native to the Abruzzo mountains.*

*Intriguing blend of Abillo and Arbarin. Silky citrus and fresh apples
with a potent minerality.*

Pure and vibrant with a savoury and herbal note.

Les Greilles, Domaine Causse Marines, Gaillac, France, 2017 **62**
*Mauzac & Loin-de-l'Oeil grapes with a little Muscadelle,
Chenin Blanc & Semillon thrown in. A complex wine that strikes a
balance between rich & acidic- perfect with sharing dishes.*

*Spring blossom, white peach aromas open up to a moreish
