A blend of Vermentino and Moscato grapes. The fermentation is done with natural yeast. This is a wonderful natural wine of real character and elegance.

Bergecrac, Château Barouillet, Bergerac, France, 2021 **49**

Delicious coupage of Sauvignon Blanc, Sauvignon Gris, Chenin and Semillon. A non traditional wine. It's easy, fun and just a little bit wild.

Lugana, Ca' lojera, Sirmione, Italy, 2020 **52**

Elegant Turbiana, crisp and very drinkable mineral wine, with incredible longevity. (Ideal Sancerre alternative).

La Blanca, Krasna Hora, Moravia, Czech Republic, 2021 **9/54**

A slightly skinty and deliciously refreshing orange. A blend from the wonderful Czech producers Krasna Hora. A perfect summer wine which has a little more substance than the average white.

Krakhuna, Mariam Guniava, Imereti, Georgia 2020 **12/68.5**

A perfect introduction to the beauty of one of the oldest grape varieties in the world. Krakhuna grape in all its expressions. A full immersion to Georgian natural wines.

Blanc, Max Sein Wein, Franken, Germany, 2019 **13.5 /70**

State of the art winery, Max is a young winemaker, who's put together a mix of Muller-Thurgau and Silvaner grapes to create this exciting, vibrant white wine. Complex but very drinkable, it express itself with time.

Hibernal, Petr Kocarik, Moravia, Czech Republic, 2019 **13.5/79**

Topette à Lundi, Domaine de Bablut, Anjoi, France, 2020 **45**

A fun, easy going Grolleau - a real thirst-quencher. From the Bablut family who have been making wines since the 1500's. In 1996, they converted back to organic and work biodynamically. Served chilled.

Rosso Piceno, Aurora, Marche, Italy, 2020 **8.5/50**

Montepulciano/Sangiovese blend. Medium bodied, fruit packed red. Delicious natural style from a lesser-explored region of Italy.

Trait Gamay, Coteaux D' Ancenis, Loire, France 2018 **11/60**

A delightful and structured Gamay: Intense, bright cherry fruit, backed up by some serious tannic structure.

Karmazin, Petr Koráb, Moravia, Czech Republic, 2020 **70**

A gorgeous Blaufränkisch with rounded, soft tannins, smooth texture and a calm acidity.

Nino's Mgaloblishvili, Archil Guniava, Imereti, Georgia, 2020 **13.5/73**

Mgaloblishvili is one of the oldest grape varieties in Georgia. It's continuous succession of flavors and smells will take you to one of the most beautiful wine countries in the world.

Field Notes 2, OffBeat, Southwest, Wiltshire, England, 2020 **14/85**

A pure-fruited, mineral combination of Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier. This wine is all about fresh fruit. Spotless and precise, but still showing plenty of character. A great example of what a British natural wine is.
