**Bergecrac, Château Barouillet, Bergerac, France 2022 54**

*An interesting, unusual wine with a fresh and zesty finish. The expressive blend of white grapes makes it fun and easy to drink.*

**Weissburgunder, Judith Beck, Burgenland, Austria, 2022 10.5/58**

*100% Pinot Blanc that has been farmed biodynamically from one of Austria's pioneers of natural wine. Light, fresh with notes of jasmine flower. This dry white wine is a perfect pairing for spiced dishes.*

**Lugana, Ca'lojera, Sirmione, Italy, 2022 69.5**

*Elegant Turbiana, an ideal Sancerre alternative. Bright and very morish wine, with incredible longevity.*

**Trinqu' Ame, La Grange Tiphaine, Loire, France, 2022 12/69.5**

*This is a clear expression of Sauvignon Blanc from the Loire valley. Aromatic, zesty with notes of green apple. A perfect spring wine with a refreshing, mineral finish.*

**Vernaccia Tradizionale, Montenedoli, San Gimignano, Tuscany, Italy, 2022 12.5/74**

*A classic expression of Vernaccia grape. Rich in texture and complexion on the palate with intriguing aromas of dried stone fruit.*

**Effusion Blanc, Patrick Baudouins, Loire, France 2021 18/108**

*Sublime and complex Chenin Blanc. Intensely aromatic with wonderful floral note. The wine is very well balanced, creamy and reveals a tight lasting finish.*

**Lune Rousse, La Ferme de Sept Lunes, St Joseph, France 2022 114**

*An elaborate and refined wine with subtle notes of lemon and apricot. It is a fresh and pure expression of the Roussanne grape that represents the St. Joseph region.*

Herrigoia, El Mozo, Rioja, Spain, 2022 **44**

*A young, energetic wine from Rioja region. The organic blend of Tempranillo and Viura creates silky tannins and elegant notes of black berries, hibiscus and spices.*

Les Frères Paquereau, Domaine de L'Epinau, Loire, France, 2022 **8/46**

*The characteristic aromas of red and spicy fruits are fully expressed in this elegant and creamy Gamay from the Loire.*

André, Syfany Winery, South Moravia, Czech Republic, 2017 **11/60**

*Andre is a grape variety of southern Moravia. The wine's notes of black fruits and sweet spices, result from maturation in wood barrels. A medium bodied wine with a garnet-red colour and soft tannins.*

Macon, Bourcier Martinot, Burgundy, France, 2022 **71**

*This Gamay perfectly reflects the terroir of Burgundy. A light-bodied wine with some fine tannins. Intense perfume of ripe fruit, a very elegant surprise from Macon Rouge region.*

Iradei, Ramón Saavedra, Andalucia, Spain, 2019 **71**

*This wine is joy in a glass. A blend of Tempranillo, Cabernet and Merlot grapes, Iradei is balanced and deep. Plenty of fruity notes, with a tad of minerality and an earthy backbone.*

Cannonau, Cantina Sorres, Sardinia, Italy, 2019 **14.5/82**

*An elegant expression of Grenache grapes with beautiful surprises in a glass. A wine full of aromas and bold textures.*

"Gea" Rosso di Montalcino, Paradiso Di Frassina, Tuscany, Italy, 2020 **15/86**

*A rare expression of Tuscany land. Light ruby in color with harmonious notes of ripe cherries and warm spices. Earthy, with a rustic long finish. 100% Sangiovese.*
